6.2.4 The need for continuity in the waterproofing protection should also be considered when selecting a type of protection. In most circumstances, the protection should be continuous.

10.1 The outer leaf of the exterior wall should be capable of controlling the quantity of water that can pass through it, in order not to exceed the drainage capacity of the system. Water entering a drained cavity system is regulated by the structure, so defects that might result in unacceptable leaks should be remedied before the system is installed.
